The Utah Cancer Control Program (UCCP), in partnership with other agencies and organizations, offers free colon cancer screening to Utahns ages 50-64.

The free cancer screening services offered include: colonoscopies, biopsies, and referral for follow-up.

Men and women ages 50-64 statewide are eligible, if they: are a legal resident of the U.S. , are a legal Utah resident, meet the income guidelines, are uninsured or underinsured, are referred to the program from a primary care provider, are at average risk for colon cancer and are asymptomatic.
