

GET A FREE PROSTATE SCREENING

▶ SIGN UP FOR A FREE PROSTATE SCREENING IN SEPTEMBER

Intermountain Cancer Services is sponsoring free prostate screenings during the month of September. Those invited are men age 50 and older who have no insurance or limited insurance, men age 40 and older who have a family history of prostate cancer, and African American men. The free screenings will include a prostate-specific antigen blood test and a digital rectal exam.

▶ WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO GET SCREENED

According to the American Cancer Society, one out of every six men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during his lifetime. Prostate cancer is the most common form of cancer found in men, other than skin cancer. Experts also say that approximately 192,000 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during 2009.
